## CHÂTEAU GRAND COLOMBIER 2016

*Montagne Saint-Emilion AOP*

### Presentation of the estate

The AOP Montagne-Saint-Emilion is a division of Saint-Emilion appellation. It is located in the extension of Saint-Emilion vineyards to the north, on the right bank of the Barbanne river. Largest municipality in the region, Montagne Saint-Emilion covers about 1600 hectares and annually produces 75,000 hectolitres of red wines. The Château Grand Colombier belongs to the Quet family since 1850. The estate is currently managed by Mr Jean-Claude Quet, his brother Jean-Pierre and his two children, David and Sophie. This new generation is at the head of 45 of vineyards, which 21 in Bordeaux, 18 in Montagne Saint Emilion, and 1,5 in Lalande de Pomerol. The owners practise a developpement policy of the quality of their wines. The family know-how and the exceptionnel soil of Château Grand Colombier allows the elaboration of great quality wines.

### Tasting comments

Deep red color.

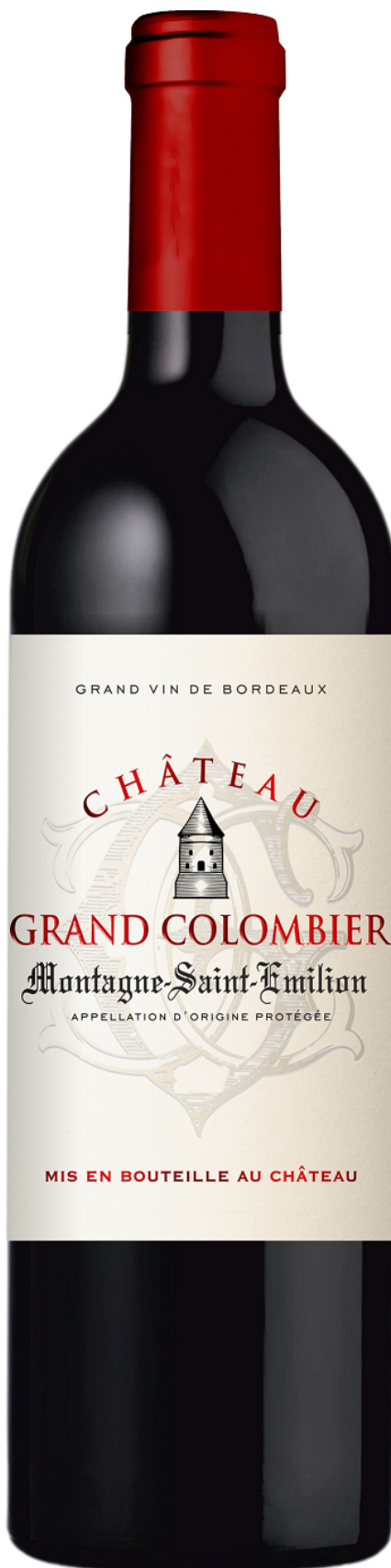
Intense nose with complex aromas of red fruits, cherries, currants and fine notes of spices.

On the palate, we find a very round wine with a nice structure, melted tannins and elegant woody notes. The tasting ends with a beautiful finish on the fruit.

Food & Wine Pairing : Red meats (duck breast, beef), cheeses or chocolate desserts

Serving condition : Between 16° and 18°C

Preservation : 7 to 8 years



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
